FALL SESSION: 9/10/2026 to 12/11/2026 WINTER/SPRING SESSION: 1/7/2027 to 5/17/2027

Arrival Date:

- * Learners may arrive to Kauai 9/8, or 9/9. No earlier please*. Also, email plane reservations as soon as you book them.
- * We recommend that you book their Christmas flight (round trip) at the same time. * (We realize that depending on availability and distance arriving on these dates may not be possible in every case...but please try)

Breaks: **Our apologies, AH does not allow visitors/friends /families to stay in the house during any breaks. **

Flight delays are not your fault. We will happily accommodate as needed.

1. Christmas Break: 12/11/26 to 1/7/2027

- * Last day before break: 12/10/2026. Christmas Eve Banquet is usually on this night.
- * Learners leave AH: on 12/11 or 12/12. * Learners arrive back to AH Kauai: on 1/7- 1/11/2027.
- **NOTICE, FOR THOSE WHO HAVE ALREADY BOOKED RETURN IN JANUARY, IF YOU CAN, AND ONLY IF YOU CAN, PLEASE ADJUST ARRIVAL DATE BETWEEN 1/7-1/11 PLEASE. ****
- Sessions begin 1/12/2027.
- * If a learner must remain on campus for special circumstances, there will be a reasonable/fair fee charged to the learner/family, paid in advance. This covers our utilities and maintenance. Cost will be determined upon request. There is no meals provided during this time. This is a case by case, and must be approved by the Board.

2. Adventure Week: March 22-29.

- * Our typical school week is disrupted as we do wild things together! This is not a week to travel except with our Anchor House learners!

3. Summer 2027

- * Anchor House Takeover Sunday is, May 16th and information will be sent out to learners/families in advance. This is also the date of their Graduation Party at the Anchor House.
- * **Last day on property: 5/17 & 5/18. No extension available** . AH books non-profit organizations for youth during this time. There is no extensions for learners to stay beyond the dates listed. Please make sure you have booked flights to return home in advance.

Visiting Your Learner (this includes family that live on Kauai or outer islands):

We love it when parents/family get a chance to visit, but please arrange your schedule so as not to pull them from class or the ministry commitments they may have (REMEMBER: AH Learners will have a busy but meaningful schedule). Our typical schedule has free time each day from noon to 4pm with Sunday morning being reserved for worship service and Monday being an entirely free day. Since all of our learners/interns will be involved in some kind of regular ministry outside of class hours, please work your visit time so that they are still able to fulfill their commitment to those who are relying on them. Parents are also welcome to sit in on any of our lectures with our guest speakers/instructors at Anchor House. Or check us out at YouTube. Look up Anchor House Kauai and subscribe please.

Unfortunately, we do not have the space ability to accommodate lodging for parents or friends of learners who wish to visit.

4. SCHOLARSHIPS: Are available only in the 2nd session. They are available on November 1st. (learners needs to put some skin in the game during first session.)And PLEASE NOTE that this will be the only reminder.

Learners must ask the registrar for the application during their 1st session. It must be filled out and sent back to kcfhome@mac.com by November 10th. This is a case by case evaluated and approved by the Scholarship Committee. Approved letters will be sent out before they leave on Christmas break.

5. Please do not fall in love with the plan.

Most of these dates are set in stone. But stones from time to time may be moved (a day or two) to accommodate a better plan. We will give you advance notice of changes, if this occurs.
